

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Incoming and continuing students must activate their registration by the registration deadline date. Change of Course, as well as full-time/part-time status, must be approved by the student's supervisor and the Graduate Program Director. These <u>forms</u> must also be submitted to the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

All students admitted to research and thesis degrees at both the Master's and Doctoral levels must have regular supervisors at the time of admission. The student is expected to have reached agreement on a mutually satisfactory course program and research program with the supervisor within six months of arrival. Generally, students concentrate on course work in the early stages of a program to acquire the necessary knowledge for the planned research work.

Graduate course credits can normally be transferred from other recognized graduate programs but, in all cases, the majority of the course requirements must be taken in the Department of Geomatics Engineering at the University of Calgary.

Students are advised that university-wide degree regulations are explicitly stated in the <u>University Calendar</u>.
