Procedures and Guidelines

for the

Master of Engineering Courses Only Route

A. For Students Including ENEL 698 in Their Programs

- 1. Requirements are ENEL 698 Graduate Project, plus 8 to 10 half courses including at least 5 graduate courses.
- 2. Registration in ENEL 698 is not permitted until all other courses have been completed or may occur concurrently with the last of the other courses.
- Students must identify a supervisor within 12 months of the initial registration. The supervisor will guide the student in ENEL 698. Students are strongly urged to identify a topic for ENEL 698 and begin preparatory work well before registering in the course.
- 4. In the event of a failure in ENEL 698, the Department will review the student's record and recommend to the Faculty of Graduate Studies whether the student should be required to withdraw or be permitted to continue. If continuation is approved, the student will retake ENEL 698.

B. For Students Not Including ENEL 698 in Their Programs

- 1. Requirements are 10 to 12 half courses including at least 7 graduate courses.
- 2. Students must identify a supervisor within 12 months of initial registration.
