Abstract Submission Eligibility Policies and Regulations

To be eligible to submit an abstract you must meet the following:

- 1) Registered full-time student at a Canadian University/Institution
- 2) Submitted abstracts must be based on the work students are performing during their current degree
- 3) All students who submit an abstract and are selected for podium, lightning, or poster presentation at the conference <u>must present their own work</u>. If you cannot attend the conference to present, then you will forfeit your spot to present, and we will fill this spot with another available student
- 4) Students selected for a podium, lightning, or poster presentation are to register and be <u>available to present at any time during the conference</u>. The organizing committee will assign your date and time of presentation before the conference

IMPORTANT

- Abstract submissions, <u>including all diagrams</u>, <u>images</u>, <u>tables</u>, <u>and references</u>, must be on ONE (1) PAGE.
- A template is available for general abstract construction, inclusions, and structure.
- PDF file format only.
- File name must be LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME_2025.pdf
- Students may submit only ONE time. Ensure your final version is double checked, we will only consider the first submission of each student.
- Abstract submissions are due Friday, August 15th at 12:00PM (noon; MST)
- Late breaking abstract submissions (poster consideration only) are due September 19th at 12:00PM (noon; MST).

Abstracts not meeting the above criteria will not be accepted, no exceptions.
