Abstract Submission Eligibility Policies and Regulations

To be eligible to submit an abstract, you must meet the following:

- 1) Registered full-time/part-time student at a Canadian University/ Institution
- 2) Submitted abstracts must be based on the work students are performing during their current degree
- 3) All students who submit an abstract and are selected for podium, lightning, or poster presentation at the conference must present their own work. If you cannot attend the conference to present, then you will forfeit your spot to present, and we will fill this spot with another available student
- 4) Students selected for a podium, lightning, or poster presentation are to register and be available to present at any time during the conference. The organizing committee will assign your date and time of presentation before the conference

IMPORTANT

- Abstract submissions, including all diagrams, images, tables, and references, must be on ONE (1) PAGE.
- A template is available for general abstract construction, inclusions, and structure.
- PDF file format only.
- File name must be LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME_2026.pdf
- Students may submit only ONE time. Ensure your final version is double checked, we will only consider the first submission of each student.
- Abstract submissions are due **Friday, August 14th at 11:59 pm MDT**.
- Late breaking abstract submissions (poster consideration only) are due **September 18th at 11:59 pm MDT**.

Abstracts not meeting the above criteria will not be accepted, no exceptions.
