Poster Presentation Guidelines

When preparing your poster consider the following guidelines:

- Be creative!
- Make use of images, graphs, figures, and tables where possible to avoid lengthy text.
- Ensure poster is easy to read by making text large and with good contract to the background.
- Clearly state important points (objectives, hypothesis, and relevance of work).
- Reduce the use of jargon and explain all acronyms.
- Be prepared to answer questions on your work.

IMPORTANT

- Posters should be prepared and printed at 36" (3 feet) wide and 48" (4 feet) tall.
- Due to space limitations, posters in the flipped "landscape" orientation are not permitted.
- Posters must include a title, list of all co-authors, and affiliated institutions.
- Please wait until after the conference if you would like to mount your poster on a rigid backing.
- Posters should be put up at the beginning of the conference and taken down at the end; please do not remove your poster early.
