

REGISTRATION CRITERIA

GRADUATING STUDENT WORKSHOP: MEMBER-IN-TRAINING (E.I.T. and G.I.T.)

NAME

You must provide your legal name when applying to APEGA. If the name appearing on your academic transcripts is not your full legal name, please use the additional name fields so that APEGA has a record of both and there are no concerns about information not matching.

RESIDENCY

There are no residency requirements for enrolment as a Member-in-Training. The online application for Member-in-Training asks for your present mailing address. **PLEASE NOTIFY APEGA OF ALL SUBSEQUENT ADDRESS CHANGES. DO NOT RELY ON POSTAL FORWARDING SERVICES.**

CITIZENSHIP

There are no citizenship requirements for enrolment as a Member-in-Training.

EDUCATION

Engineering

The Canadian Engineering Accreditation Board (CEAB), a subgroup of Engineers Canada, sets standards for engineering education and inspects all engineering schools for compliance with these standards. Graduates of accredited programs are academically qualified for enrolment as Members-in-Training.

Geoscience (Geology & Geophysics)

There is no national accreditation system for geoscience. Transcripts from all geoscience applicants are compared to the Geoscience Knowledge & Experience Requirements (GKE) developed by Geoscientists Canada. Applicants with degrees from the University of Alberta, University of Calgary and Mount Royal University usually meet these requirements.

CHARACTER

Members-in-Training must be of good character and reputation. The online application includes a Declaration of Good Character and Reputation. An affirmative answer to any question does not necessarily mean that you will be refused enrolment. If information on the declaration raises concern about your character, you will be given an opportunity to respond to the concern in writing.

PROFESSIONAL STATUS

A Member-in-Training is not a registered or practicing member of APEGA. A Member-in-Training may only do engineering or geoscience work under the supervision of a fully registered, practicing Professional Member or Licensee.

ENROLLMENT TIMELINE

After you attend the APEGA Ethics Workshop and submit your Request for Academic Documents form, an online application must be completed to finalize your request for enrolment with APEGA.

You will have a limited timeframe to initiate your application. Once initiated, you will have 90 days to complete and submit the application with the \$40.00 + GST processing fee. At the end of the 90 day period, APEGA will process all submitted Member-In-Training: Student Workshop applications as a batch and request your graduation information from your university.

It may take up to 6 months for the entire enrollment process to be fully completed.
