

Frequently Asked Questions: APEGA Graduating Students' Workshop

Camp 18 and APEGA are two distinct and separate organizations who operate independently but cooperatively. APEGA hosts the workshop prior to the Earth and Iron Ring Ceremonies. Please direct any questions regarding either ceremony to either Camp 18, Corporation of the Seven Wardens, or the Earth Ring Stewards.

Workshop:

- 1) Do I have to attend the APEGA Workshop?
Attending the workshop is not mandatory; however, if you do not attend then you are not eligible for the special Graduating Student Workshop Member-In-Training application. If you miss this opportunity, you may apply for Member-In-Training status on our website using the online application form and will be required to pay the regular application processing fees.
- 2) Where can I find the agenda and timing for the day?
The agenda is included with the Graduating Students' Application forms. These forms are available to graduates when signing up and sizing for the iron ring at the Engineering Student Centre or in the provided Geoscience Student Kit.
- 3) Is there a cost for the workshop?
There is no cost to attend the workshop. There is a \$40.00 processing fee due upon submission of your completed online application form.
- 4) If a graduate misses the deadline to sign up for the workshop, who can he/she contact to see whether he/she may still attend?
The Calgary APEGA Office closes registration for this event 10 days prior to the event date. The current contact is Anita Denton at events@apega.ca or 1-800-661-7020. However, you will not be able to participate in the Ring Ceremony if you did not register prior to the deadline date. - 5) How do I sign up for the workshop?
*If you are an Engineering Graduate from the U of C, please sign up through the Schulich School of Engineering online registration form.
If you are a Geoscience Graduate at the U of C or MRU, sign up at the Department of Geoscience at the same time you register for the Earth Ring Ceremony.*
- 6) There are multiple workshop rooms and times. How do I know which workshop I attend?
APEGA will contact you via email with the correct room and time of your workshop. Because we have limited space, adjustments cannot be made to accommodate students who arrive at a time other than that specified in the APEGA email. Please ensure you attend at the time you are scheduled.

Graduating Student Application Forms for Member-In-Training:

- 1) Who are these forms for?
The request for academic document forms are for graduates of a Bachelor of Science program in engineering, geology or geophysics from the U of C, U of A or Mount Royal University. This form is not an application. You will still be required to fill out an online application.

Anyone who is graduating from a graduate program will apply using the online application available on our website and will be required to pay regular application processing fees.
